4	Vayera (Gen 18:1–22:24)	Hospitality, justice, prayer; the Akedah and testing.
5	Chayei Sarah (Gen 23:1–25:18)	Legacy, stewardship, partnership; community continuity.
6	Toldot (Gen 25:19–28:9)	Sibling dynamics; choice, responsibility, succession.
7	Vayetze (Gen 28:10–32:3)	Vision, vows, work; integrity and commitments.
8	Vayishlach (Gen 32:4–36:43)	Reconciliation, identity transformation, power & vulnerability.
9	Vayeshev (Gen 37:1–40:23)	Joseph I: dreams, injustice, resilience, moral complexity.
10	Miketz (Gen 41:1–44:17)	Joseph II: wisdom, stewardship, governance, foresight.
11	Vayigash (Gen 44:18–47:27)	Responsibility, forgiveness, reconciliation.
12	Vayechi (Gen 47:28–50:26)	Blessing, legacy, ethical vision; course integration.
